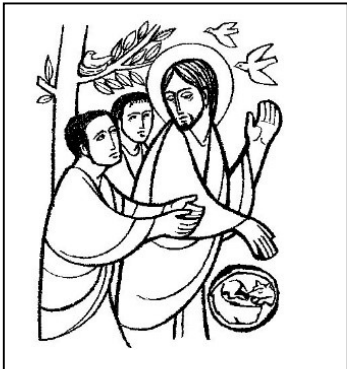


**THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

In this week's First Reading, Elijah's disciple is allowed to kiss his parents goodbye before setting out to follow the prophet's call.



But we are called to follow a "greater than Elijah", this week's Liturgy wants us to know.

In Baptism, we have put on the cloak of Christ, been called to the house of a new Father, and been given a new family in the kingdom of God. We have

been called to leave behind our past lives and never look back—to follow wherever He leads.

Elijah was taken up in a whirlwind and his disciple was given a double portion of his spirit.

Jesus too, the Gospel reminds us, was "taken up", and He gave us His Spirit to live by, to guide us in our journey in His kingdom.

As this week's Epistle tells us, the call of Jesus shatters the yoke of every servitude, sets us free from the rituals of the old Law, and shows us the Law's fulfillment in the following of Jesus, in serving one another through love.

His call sets our hands to a new plow, a new task—to be His messengers, sent ahead to prepare all peoples to meet Him and enter into His Kingdom.

Elijah called down fire to consume those who wouldn't accept God. But we have a different Spirit with us.

To live by His Spirit is to face opposition and rejection, as the Apostles do in this week's Gospel. It is to feel like an exile, with no lasting city, no place in this world to lay our head or call home.

But we hear the voice of the One we follow in this week's Psalm. He calls us to make His faith our own—to abide in confidence that He will not abandon us, that He will show us "the path to life," leading us to the fullness of joy in His presence forever.

Please pray for the souls Teresa Reda, Steven James Villella, Celestino Natola whose funerals were celebrated during this past week in our Church.

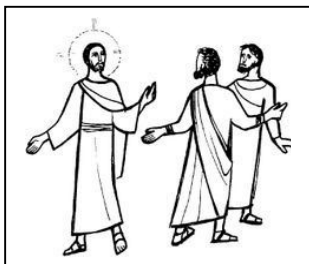
**SUMMER COLLECTION**

Attorno a Gesù si raccoglie un manipolo di giovani e uomini che lo seguono con entusiasmo. Tuttavia non è facile accettare le condizioni che egli pone. Esige, si direbbe, più del giusto. Vuole tutto, non

lascia niente per nussun altro, nemmeno per la persona che lo segue.

Il simbolo ha enorme importanza nelle manifestazioni ed espressioni religiose. Simbolo significativo e trasparente è quello di Elia, che getta il suo mantello sulle spalle di Eliseo; questi sacrifica i buoi e brucia gli attrezzi ad indicare che indietro non si torna.

Leggeremo un trattatello sulla libertà con tre indicazioni forti: la libertà è aualità primaria della fede, l'amore è la legge onnicomprensiva, la lotta tra spirito e carne è la condizione esistenziale dell'uomo.

Gesù intraprende alla volta di Gerusalemme u viaggio che in Luca occupa dieci capitoli, quasi metà del suo Vangelo. Il rigiuto dell'ospitalità da parte dei samaritani fa vedere come la pensano gli apostoli-almeno due esponenti di primo piano-e come la pensa Gesù. Tre uomini vogliono farsi discepoli di Gesù:ricevono risposte decisamente scoraggianti. Non sappiamo come i tre abbiano reagito: di certo molti hanno seguito e seguono Gesù, niente affatto spaventati dalle sue esigenze.
